Specifications: Entrants are limited only by imagination, ability and the following:

- Maximum size of work in any direction is 4 feet.

- Work must be framed, wired, and ready to be hung*.
- Work must be clearly labeled with the artist's name, name of work, price, and contact information.

- Artists are encouraged to submit a 1-2 page bio (typed and printed or emailed to submissions@upstateartistsguild.org) with their entry.

Entry checklist:

1. Completed and signed entry form
2. Cash or check/money order made out to UAG or payment through PayPal.
3. Digital or printed images. Do not send actual work.
4. Artist's Bio

Entry procedure and fees: Artists are encouraged to submit by emailing images and entry form information to submissions@upstateartistsguild.org. Or please present prints or digital images on cd with this submission form.

Submissions must be received by midnight on **February 13th 2009**. Each artist may submit up to 5 pieces. Submission fee for this show is \$10 for UAG members in good standing or \$25 for non-members. **Off-line Submissions must be clearly labeled with:**

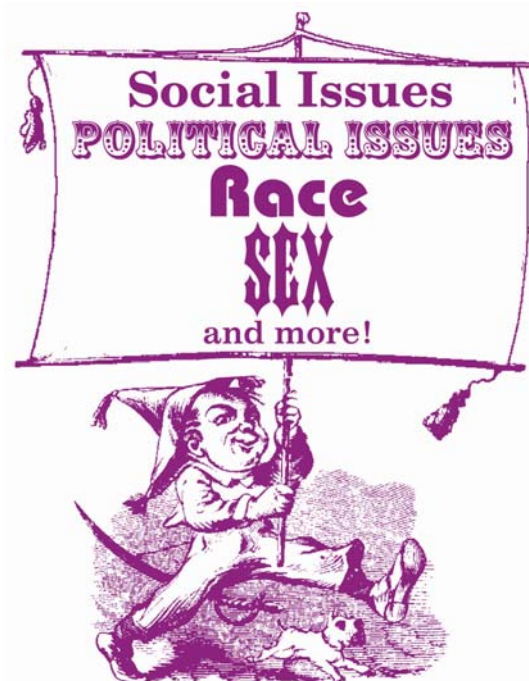
- Artist's name
- Title of work
- Medium
- Size (HxW, xD if applicable)

Drop off dates for accepted work are Saturday, February 28th and Sunday, March 1st from 2 - 6 P.M.

Sales: Although artists may opt for their work to be Not For Sale, we encourage you to price your work. The UAG Gallery is not-for-profit and depends on the sales handling fees, membership dues, and charitable donations to cover operating expenses. No pricing changes will be allowed after acceptance.

Artists whose work is sold through the UAG will be charged a Sales Handling Fee of 25%. (UAG 25% /Artist 75%).

Works not sold by March 27th must be picked up on March 28th/March 29th from 2-6PM or by special arrangement.

Exhibition dates. Opening reception will be First Friday, March 6, 6:00 - 9:00. Artists are encouraged to attend and donate food for the opening.

March 28th/29th 2p-6p

All works must be picked up on the 28th or 29th, between 2 and 6 pm. Please contact the Gallery Manager ahead of time if other arrangements are necessary. **THE UAG CANNOT STORE WORK.**
