Eligibility: Open to all artists in Upstate New York. All media is permitted. Work must have been completed in the last 24 months and not previously shown at a UAG event. Work must be able to be hand delivered and picked up on the dates specified.

THE UAG CANNOT STORE WORK!!!

Specifications: Entrants are limited only by imagination, ability, and the following:

- ◆ Maximum size of work in any direction is 4 feet.
- ◆ Work must be framed, wired, and ready to hang*.
- ◆ Work must be clearly labeled with the artist's name, name of work, price, and contact information.

Entry checklist:

1. Completed and signed entry form
2. Cash or check/money order made payable to UAG or payment through PayPal
3. Digital or printed images. Do not send actual work.
4. Artists are encouraged to submit a 1-2 page bio (typed and printed or emailed to: submissions@upstateartistsguild.org) with their entry.

Entry procedure and fees: Artists are encouraged to email images and submission form information to: submissions@upstateartistsguild.org. If you can not submit by email, please present prints or digital images on CD with this submission form.

Submissions and Submission forms must be received by midnight on **June 11th, 2010**. Each artist may submit up to 5 pieces. Submission fee for this show is \$10 for UAG members in good standing or \$25 for non-members. **Non emailed submissions must be clearly labeled with:**

- ◆ Artist's name
- ◆ Title of work
- ◆ Medium
- ◆ Size (HxWxD, if applicable)

Drop of dates for accepted work are Saturday June 19th and Sunday June 20th from 2pm-6pm. **Please contact the Gallery Manager ahead of time if other arrangements are necessary.**

Sales: Although artists may opt for their work to be Not For Sale, we encourage you to price your work. The UAG Gallery is not-for-profit and depends on the sales handling fees, membership dues, and charitable donations to cover operating expenses. **No pricing changes will be allowed after acceptance.**

Artists whose work is sold through the UAG will be charged a Sales Handling Fee of 25% (UAG 25% / Artist 75%).

Works not sold by March 26th must be picked up on March 27th/28th from 2-6pm or by special arrangement.

Exhibition dates. Opening reception will be First Friday, July 2nd, 6:00 - 9:00pm. Artists are encouraged to attend and donate food for the opening.

July 24th/25th 2p-6p

All works must be picked up on the 24th or 25th, between 2 and 6pm. Please contact the Gallery Manager ahead of time if other arrangements are necessary. **THE UAG CANNOT STORE WORK.**
